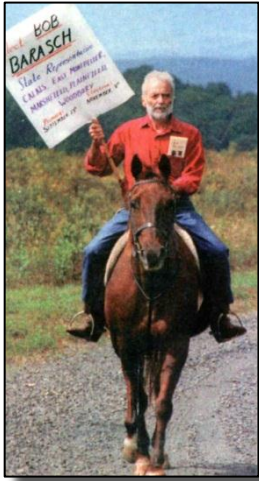

Born in 1926, Robert Barasch grew up in northwest Alabama where he watched steamboats from a bluff near his family's house a block from the Tennessee River. After graduating from high school he served in the Army, attended several colleges and worked as the editor of newspapers, textbooks and technical reports before graduating with separate degrees in zoology and clinical psychology. His experiences include a run for a Legislative seat. He retired from the practice and teaching of psychology in 1996 and returned to writing poetry and fiction. He moved to Vermont with his family more than 40 years ago.
